Health Requirements by Grade

These are mandated by the State of Illinois.

Pre-K:

Physical Exam- on Illinois form, signed & dated by physician. Parents complete top of form, sign & date, doctor will fill out the rest. Just one exam for both years of PreK. Due by Oct 1st.

Immunization Record- All shots need to be up-to-date according to the Health Department or your physician. Usually (4)Dtop. (3)Polio. (3 or 4)Hib (3)HepB. (1)MMR. (1)Varicella. (4) Pneumo. Due by Oct 1st. Birth Certificate- with official seal, provided once to the main office.

Kindergarten & New/Transfer Students (due within the first month of attendance):

Physical Exam- on Illinois form, signed & dated by physician. Parents complete top of form, sign & date, doctor will fill out the rest. Due by Oct 1st.

Immunization Record- All shots need to be up-to-date according to the Health Department or your physician. Due by Oct 1st. Usually (5) Dtap, (4) Polio, (3) Hep B, (2) MMR, (2) Varicella, (4) Pneumo. Most Kindergarterers need at least 2 combination shots.

Eye Exam- on Illinois form Due by Oct 1st (by an optometrist, not the same as a school screening)

Dental Exam- On Illinois form due by the middle of March, dated from November of the previous school year. Or fill out "Miles of Smiles" application.

Birth Certificate- with official seal, provided once to the main office.

Second Grade:

Dental Exam- On Illinois form due by the middle of March, dated from November of the previous school year. Or fill out "Miles of Smiles" application.

Sixth Grade:

Physical Exam- on Illinois form, signed & dated by physician. Parents complete top of form, sign & date, doctor will fill out the rest. Due by Oct 1^{st} .

Immunization Record- All shots need to be up-to-date according to the Health Department or your physician. Most need MCV (meningitis) & Tdap. Due by Oct 1st.

Dental Exam- On Illinois form by the middle of March, dated from November of the previous school year. Or fill out "Miles of Smiles" application.

Freshmen:

Physical Exam- on Illinois form, signed & dated by physician. Parents complete top of form, sign & date, doctor will fill out the rest. (& Catch up with Immunizations if needed) Due by Oct 1st. Dental Exam- On Illinois form due by the middle of March, dated from November of the *previous school year*. Or fill out "Miles of Smiles" application.

Senior:

Immunization- 2nd MCV (meningitis). (Only one dose needed if 1st given after 16th birthday) Due by Oct 1st.

*All Athletes * All previous Health Reg's must be met! - before first practice of the season + Gen Physical or IHSA Sports physical form - either one good for sports for 13 months.
